WHERE:

- Location of Work: 2911 Clark Blvd
- Traffic, Dust, and Noise Inconvenience: Along Clark Blvd between Canada Ave & New York Ave
- Fire Hydrants To Be Out of Service: (1) fire hydrant at intersection of Clark Blvd & Canada Ave
- Interruption of Water Services: 2900 & 3000 Blocks of Clark Blvd

WHY: Waterline Connection

PROJECT: District 4 – Clark Apartments

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: ALCE Construction, a private contractor, will be installing a waterline connection at 2911 Clark Blvd. Work will cause temporary traffic, dust, and noise inconvenience and (1) fire hydrant to be out of service at the location of work. Water services **will be** affected by this work at the locations mentioned above.

Work will take approximately **three** (3) **hours**, for completion of work, weather permitting. Progress updates will be made available by the Utilities Department.

Motorists and pedestrians are cautioned to avoid the construction area completely and to take alternate routes, or to use extreme caution when traveling through the area. Residents are urged to adhere to all posted traffic control signs, digital message boards, and devices in order to provide safety to all citizens and minimize traffic congestion in the affected area.
